Customs seize cigarettes worth RM1m

BENTONG: The Pahang Customs Department has seized various brands of contraband cigarettes and a three-tonne lorry valued at RM1,519,104 during a raid on a shop at the Tanjung Minyak Perdana Industrial Park in Malacca.

Its director Mohd Asri Seman said the raid was conducted on Aug 27 by the Bentong Customs branch following intelligence received.

"The seizure, which included 1,812,000 cigarette sticks, is valued at RM157,440, with unpaid duties and taxes amounting to RM1,211,664."

He said the cigarettes are believed to have originated from several countries and been smuggled by sea through the Straits of Malacca.

"We are investigating the shop owner and the lorry to identify the mastermind behind the illegal cigarette distribution syndicate."

"We suspect that the shop was used to store contraband and the lorry was used to transport the goods during peak hours to avoid detection." – Bernama
